2026 Term 1 begins on Saturday, 24th January.

Year 4 (in 2026) Term 1 courses are designed to ensure that students meet the high academic standards expected for forthcoming OC placement tests. For students who haven't yet enrolled in the OC Trial Test Course (OCTTC), we strongly recommend starting in Term 1. The exam date has been advanced to 8 & 9 May, making timely preparation crucial.

The OCTTC will teach students how to manage their time effectively, reduce mistakes, and perform their best on the OC placement tests.

Year 4 WEMT Course

Year 4 WEMT course is introducing the new modules with its updated curriculum. It requires a significant commitment of weekly module work to help students build a solid foundation for the 2026 OC exam.

The **writing** module teaches students the most efficient ways in organising writing structure. **English** lesson will focus on reading skills, practising reading comprehension and multiple-choice questions. **Mathematics** lessons are essential for students to thoroughly understand mathematical theories, principles and formulas to solve problems. **Thinking skills** lesson covers a variety of practical, challenging and mind-stimulating questions in problem solving and critical thinking skills.

OC Trial Test Course (OCTTC)

Year 4 OC Trial Test Course (OCTTC) is significant for students who will sit for the 2026 OC placement test. It provides weekly tests which enables assessment of knowledge and test performance.

- By taking OC trial tests on a weekly basis, students will be able to systematically build up their exam skills and be confidently prepared for the actual exam.
- The course consists of different types of questions and reflects the format, timing and conditions of the actual exam. It will help students to manage the test time efficiently, minimise errors, overcome exam nerves and perform at his or her optimum level.
- Students will attempt the mathematical reasoning & thinking skills tests in one week and reading tests in the following week, taking 2 weeks for a set of OC trial tests. After the test, students will go through the questions with teacher, putting more focus on difficult questions.

Year 4 Writing Course (Wednesday)

The aim of the Year 4 Writing course is to improve students' technical and imaginative writing skills. The course has a personalised approach to cater to each student's specific writing needs, which fosters confidence, competence, and expertise in writing.

This program will aid students in improving their writing skills for all written assignments at school, as well as writing exams for NAPLAN, ICAS Assessments and selective school exam.

Emphasis will be placed on narrative, information report, poetry, diary, persuasive writing skills, including grammar, spelling, and punctuation, which are crucial components of the course curriculum.

Additionally, students will be encouraged to apply their knowledge to create meaningful and coherent sentences in their writing exercises.
