Year 5 WEMT Course

Year 5 WEMT course has undergone updates to its curriculum. It demands a significant weekly commitment to aid students in establishing a sturdy foundation for the 2024 selective school exam.

The writing module instructs students on the most effective methods for organising writing structure, with an emphasis on developing critical thinking and reasoning abilities. English lessons concentrate on reading proficiency and practice with reading comprehension and multiple-choice questions. The mathematics lessons are crucial for students to comprehend mathematical theories, principles, and formulas, allowing them to solve problems with ease. The thinking skills module offers a range of practical, challenging, and mindstimulating questions in problem solving and critical thinking.

Students have the option to select one of the following WEMT courses based on their individual needs:

Standard WEMT(Face-to-face learning): Face-to-face learning in class & access all Cyberschool services

Cyber WEMT(Video lesson): Self-paced learning from home using prerecorded Cyberschool video lessons

Selective Trial Test Course (STTC)

Year 5 Selective Trial Test Course (STTC) is an extensive program aimed at preparing students for the 2024 Selective High School Placement Test. The course encompasses a variety of question types, simulating the format, timing, and conditions of the actual exam.

Throughout the course, students will participate in weekly trial tests and will learn the most effective ways to tackle selective exam style questions. They are expected to download and memorise the vocabularies provided on Cyberschool and take the online vocab practice test.
